I am writing to provide status of records responsive to OCPD-2885-2026.

1. Current and historical policies, SOPs, directives.
 - Published OKCPD Police Operations Manual.
2. Training materials and guidance governing use of Flock Safety ALPR.
 - OKCPD has training/guidance material for internal/law enforcement use only.
3. Access controls and authorization.
 - No responsive records are available. We can access controls and authorizations on the website; we have not published reports listing controls and authorizations.
4. Prohibited uses and enforcement discipline standards.
 - No responsive records are available. In internal use guidelines, we mention this is for legitimate Law Enforcement use only and we do not have discipline standards published specifically for Flock.
5. Audit logging requirements and audit procedures.
 - No responsive records are available. Internal guidance requires a case number or case type. This is not in a policy or SOP that has been published, only internal guidance. No audit procedures exist in policies, SOPs, directives, training or guidance for Flock.
6. Transparency reporting or internal usage reporting.
 - No responsive records are available. There is no transparency reporting or internal usage reporting in our policies, SOPs, directives, training or guidance materials. We have not published transparency/internal use reports.

Please advise if additional clarification, follow-up searches, or further review are needed.
